GROUND RULES:	<p>Ground Rules NWDCR 2009</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stalls will be available from the TRAC facilities @ \$15.00 per stall per horse per night. No overnight tying of horses to trailers and no set up of portable panels 2. Individuals not paying for stall fees will be assessed additional fees at the rate of \$50 per animal, per day, per stall. 3. Any person harassing workers/security personnel about the cost or use of the stalls will not be permitted to leave horses in stalls, and may not tie to vehicles/trailers. 4. Extra shavings will be available at \$7.00 per bale. 5. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Absolutely no DOGS ALLOWED IN THE TRAC INDOOR FACILILTIES. 6. Horses may not be tied or left unattended inside the TRAC Indoor Facility at any time. 7. No individuals may sit on rails or fences. 8. Only the contestant competing will be allowed in the arena. 9. When contestants check into the rodeo office they will receive wristbands which must be worn for the weekend. Lost wristbands will be replaced at a cost of \$5.00.

	<p>10. No contestant parking inside of back gate of TRAC. All contestants will park out in designated area.</p> <p>11. Contestants “MUST” have wristband on their wrist before entering the arena area or they will be asked to leave until they have it on.</p> <p>12. TRADES MAY BE MADE ON SECOND (2) ANIMAL/RUN ONLY. TRADES MUST BE AGREED UPON BY BOTH PARTIES AND PHONED IN 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF FIRST PERFORMANCE.</p> <p>13. IF A TRADE IS GOING TO BE MADE THE MORNING AFTER THE FIRST ROUND AND BEFORE THE SECOND ROUND IS STARTED BOTH CONTESTANTS MUST COME IN AND SIGN A TRADE SLIP IN PERSON WITH THE SECRETARY, OR TRADE WILL NOT BE EXCEPTED AND CONTESTANTS WILL TAKE ORIGINAL STOCK/RUN. TRADE MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE DRAW FOR SECOND (2) ROUND BEGINS. ONCE THE DRAW FOR TH SECOND ROUND HAS STARTED NO OTHER TRADES CAN BE MADE AT THAT POINT FOR ANY EVENTS.</p> <p>14. ANYONE CAUGHT NOT FOLLOWING THESE RULES WILL BE CONSIDERED “ATTEMPTING TO CHEAT” AND WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THAT PERFORMANCE, AND WILL FORFIT ANY SCORE/TIME OR MONEY WON FOR THAT PERFORMANCE.</p>

For rough stock events with 24 or less entries the 2 head will stand, if 25 or above the rough stock will be 1 head for the better of the performance. 2. If 20 or less entries, we will pay 4 places, 21-35 we will pay 5 places, 36 and above we will pay 6 places. 3. We will pay per round and a average for the 8 rodeo events.
