

Blaise Black Memorial Scholarship

The Blaise Black Memorial Scholarship was established to support the education of college students who are also involved in rodeo. This scholarship(s) will be supported and administered through the Blaise Black Memorial Scholarship Foundation under the following guidelines:

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Scholarship(s) will be awarded to a student(s) enrolled full time in an accredited college, university, or technical school.
2. The scholarship(s) will not be renewed automatically; however, eligible students are encouraged to apply more than once, availability of the scholarship permitting.
3. Disbursement of the scholarship will be to the student's account, or to the student upon presentation of tuition receipt.
4. Consideration of the scholarship will be made upon a combination of expressed educational goals, student's contribution to rodeo, expressed impact of rodeo for student, and with regard to financial need. A reference will be included for support to student's written application.
5. A scholarship committee designated by the Foundation Board will be responsible for determining scholarship winner(s).
6. The amount of the scholarship(s) will be determined by the Board based on current funds available.
7. The scholarship deadline will be May 1, with notice of award by May 15.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Application
- Essay of how scholarship will be used in attaining educational goals of applicant
- Description of involvement in rodeo (and the ICA, in particular) and what rodeo has meant to you.
- One letter of recommendation.
