

Rule Proposals for General Membership Meeting October 6, 2018

#1 Rule Proposal submitted by: Heather Paradis, Matt Askew Added B.3 (see italics)

B. NON-CONTESTING MEMBERS (revised 2015)

1. Non-contesting members shall be:

A. Judges, Timers, Secretaries, Announcers, Bull Fighters, Pickup men and Committees annual card fee shall be \$30.

B. Stock Contactors and Photographer annual card fee shall be \$100.

2. Secretaries who are members of a committee are not required to have a card for that rodeo

3. *If a Non-Contesting member works a rodeo without first purchasing an ICA card, the Non-Contesting member that worked a rodeo will be subject to a fine no less than \$100 per infraction and become ineligible to work other ICA events including but not limited to the finals. In the event that the stock contractor hired the non-contesting member, they also will be subject to fine no less than \$100 per infraction.*

Rationale for Proposal: Members should be responsible for purchasing their cards prior to working an event. A committee should not be held financially responsible for a member not purchasing their card.

#2 Rule Proposal from Matt Nauman: Change the pay scale in the tie-down roping to match the other timed events.

\$3501-5000 8 places 23/20/17/14/11/8/5/2

#3 Rule Proposed by Heather Paradis & Kevin Hensen

Added 3.6 (see italics)

3. Novice Members

1. Novice membership is for Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding and Bull Riding.
2. Novice member dues are \$50 (Revised 2017).
3. All Novice riders must have an ICA Novice Card. (2014)
4. Novice riders can be of either gender. (2014)
5. Novice age limit will be 21 years old as of January 1 of that year. (To start in 2019)
6. *In the event that the contestant competes in multiple events to include a Novice and a non novice event, they must get approval from the board and will be required to purchase the more expensive card if approved.*

Rationale for proposal: To clarify multiple event cowboy requirements (Novice and RB, or Novice and Timed Event etc.).

#4 Rule Proposed by Heather Paradis & Kevin Hensen

Added to #2 of Novice Events (see italics)

NOVICE EVENTS

1. The ICA will encourage rodeos to have novice events in the Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding and Bull Riding.
2. Novice riders can only enter novice events within the year they are declared novice riders. Once the Novice rider wins over 40 points, the Novice rider advances to the open events the next rodeo season. (2014) Points will be accrued for the lifetime of the Novice contestant. Novice Riders will be awarded points for each place they receive as follows:
1st Place: 10 points
2nd Place: 8 points
3rd Place: 6 points

4th Place: 4 points

If a Novice Rider competes in more than one Novice event, they will advance out of novice as soon as they accumulate more than 40 points in one of the novice events.

3. Entry fees for novice events will be \$20 in the purse. In addition, novice entries will pay the other associated fees as in other events (Finals Fund, Judges Fee, Central entry fee, and committee charge. In the event that no one qualifies in a novice event, the \$20 per contestant purse will be paid to the ICA and go directly into the finals fund for that novice event. Added money will be kept by the committee.

Rational for Proposal: To clarify multiple Novice event cowboy point requirements (points not combined across multiple events, however once you advance due to points in one event, you go to a full member in both events).

#5 Proposed by Ellie Beukelman New Rule to I. Womens Barrel Racing

Late Entries

- 1) If a late entry is taken by the secretary or Rodeo Central the contestant will be added to the bottom of the drag, not the bottom of the competing list.
- 2) If the late entry is taking the place of a contestant that is drawing/vetting out, the late entry will go to the bottom of the drag, not the contestant's position they are taking.
- 3) Late Entries must be approved by the ICA Secretary, Stock Contractor, and event director

#6 Proposed by Ellie Beukelman New Rule in addition to 12 under Heading: I. Womens Barrel Racing

If the gate is center and conditions are safe/clear outside that gate, the gate is to remain open so the contestant can run in and out during the barrel racing
