Awards: Buckles or Trophy Spurs will be awarded for first place in all ICA events and Local events as specified below.

Local Events: Call Jordan Paradis @208-741-2748 July 16-18th

- Local Barrels: Adams and Washington County Only. You must Reside in the County. (18 and under/19 and over) Limited to 5 per perf. (Buckle to First place JR/SR)
- Local Team Roping: One Person must **Reside** in Adams County (No exceptions) (Buckles to winners)
- Hide Racing: Open to Everyone (Prize to winning team)
- Wild Cow Milking: One Person must **Reside** in Adams County (No exceptions) (Buckles to winners)
- Pre Rodeo:
 - Mutton Busting Under 6 years of age and under 55 lbs (Buckle each night)
 - Steer Riding (Rodeo Fever) 13 and Under. (Buckle for high score of all three nights)

*Residing in the County is defined as physically living in the County for more than 75% of the past year.

All Around will be given to an Adams County Resident. Must compete in any 2 events. See office for rules.

Ground Rules:

Contestant Parking in designated areas only. Overnight camping allowed in designated areas for a fee. You are responsible for your trash.

Warm Up Arena located by Fair Building.

Dogs must be on a leash

All pre-rodeo contestants are asked to compete and then vacate from behind the chutes to allow room for the ICA contestants.

Visiting Rodeo Royalty will be given one pass to enter the Rodeo (No companion). You must check in by Office to buzz at least 1.5 hrs prior to Grand Entry. There will be a royalty area to sit and sign autographs etc., but we ask that you please stay out of the way of the contestant areas.
