- Local Team Roping: One Person must **Reside** in Adams County (No exceptions)
- Hide Racing: One person must Reside in Adams County
- Pre Rodeo:
 - Mutton Busting Under 6 years of age and under 55 lbs
 - Steer Riding (Rodeo Fever) 13 and Under Sunday Only
 - Mini Ponies Saturday Only 13 and Under

*Residing in the County is defined as physically living in the County for more than 75% of the past year.
