Ground Rules

- The Grande Ronde Rodeo Committee is working to put on a professional and timely rodeo event for both the contestant and spectators' enjoyment.
- All contestants will be ready to compete when called upon. 1 min time limit to get out after name is called – at head judges' discretion.
- All contestants must park in a designated parking area.
- No overnight tying of horses.
- Warm up arena is available for use.

- Performance must be full before slack is offered.
- 1 companion pass will be given to each contestant. Children 14 and under accompanied by an adult with a companion pass will be admitted free of charge.
- Limited space behind the chute for roughstock contestants. You will be allowed one person to assist. All pre-rodeo contestants must vacate following pre-rodeo prior to rodeo start time.

Local Events:

- Mini Bulls: Will be limited to 8 contestants per night and will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Mini Bulls will be IMBRA and ICA sanctioned. There will be 2 classes. Riders 9-11 JR Mini Bulls and riders 12-14 SR mini bulls. The weight limit for all riders is 135lbs.
- Pony Riders will be limited to 8 contestants per night for contestants 14 and under and will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. The weight limit for all riders is 135lbs.
- Mutton Busting will be limited to 8 per night and will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Children ages 4-7 with a maximum weight of 60 lbs. (on the day of the ride) are eligible to ride sheep in the competition.
- Local Barrels: JR 14 and under – limit of 6 each night. Sr 15 and older – Limit of 10 each night.
- Local Team Roping – Open to residents of Union, Baker and Wallowa Counties.
